New Sunday Mass Schedule: The weekend of our new Sunday Mass Schedule has arrived. As I am sure you all have memorized by now, Sunday (and Saturday Evening) Masses are as follows: Sunday Vigil Mass (Saturday Evening Mass) at 5:00 p.m., Sunday at 8:00 a.m., 10:45 a.m., and 5:00 p.m. Our new hymnals have arrived. We will be introducing our first new Hymnal "You are Holy" at our Sunday evening Mass. As previously announced, the Sunday Evening Mass will feature "Praise and Worship" music. The plan is that this Mass will slowly grow into this style of music. It is also "ad experimentum" as we discern the needs of our community and our resources.

Faith Formation Opportunities: Over the last few weeks, we have highlighted a number of opportunities for our parishioners to grow in faith this fall. Sunday mornings, between the Masses, all parishioners are invited to our "RCIA" program for a refresher course on the Catholic faith. Sunday evenings, we will have Financial Peace University as a way of growing in our discipleship in the area of personal finance. Mondays (starting October 2) we will have the Women's Bible Study "Walking With Purpose." On the First Tuesday of every month, we have our monthly "Band of Brothers" hosted by the Blessed Sacrament Catholic Men's Ministry. We have begun Alpha (it is not too late to start) on Thursdays from 6:30-8:30 p.m. If you haven't already done so, I encourage you to take advantage of at least one of these opportunities! Check the bulletin for more details.

Hurricanes, Earthquakes, and other Natural Disasters: Please pray for all who have been affected by the recent storms and earthquakes. Our prayers go beyond our borders to all our fellow human beings who have been afflicted in these past weeks. I encourage you to look for ways to help out those who have lost so much.
