### Spiritual Adoption

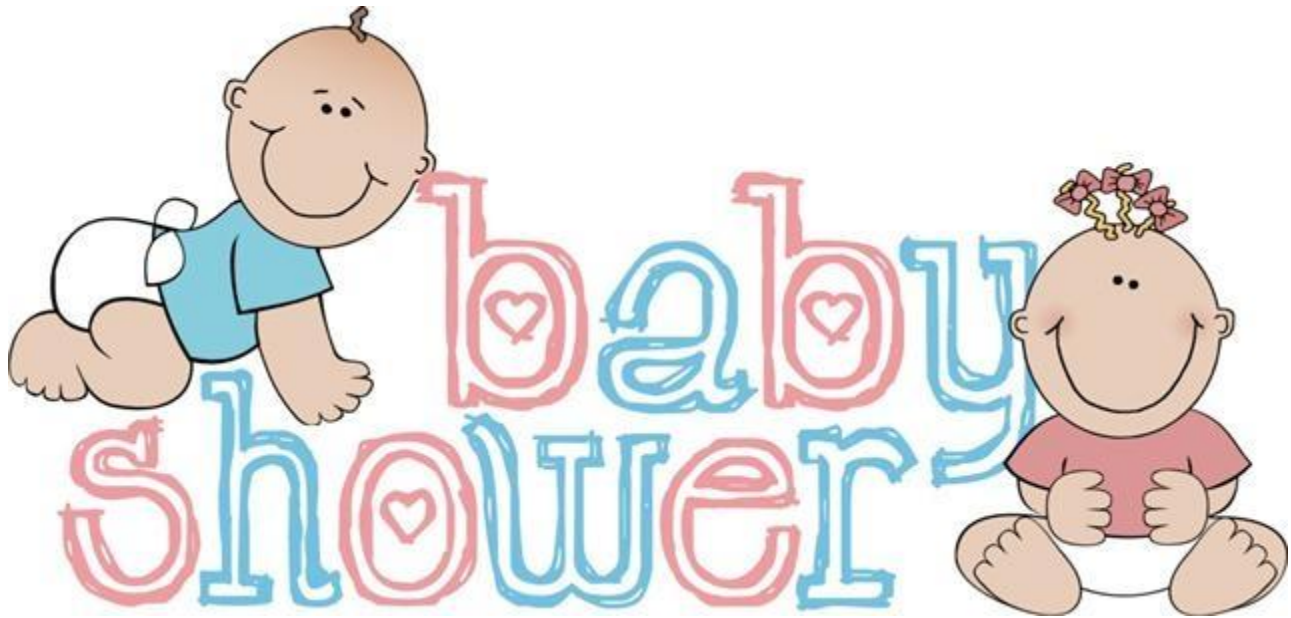
